The Lewiston Roundup Association cares deeply about our community, our events, and our attendees that make what we do so special. Given the ongoing outbreak of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), we want to provide as much clarity as possible on how this impacts our upcoming events.

Who is LRA partnering with to monitor coronavirus and be prepared?

As the COVID-19 virus continues to spread throughout our surrounding areas, we understand this is a fluid situation, and we are in constant communication with our local and state partners as this evolves. This includes the State of Idaho, the Idaho North Central District of Public Health, and others. Additionally, resources at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention are being utilized.

What preventative steps is LRA taking?

In regards to Horseman's Ball, LRA will have additional hand sanitizing stations available inside the venue, and will have additional event venue staffing to serve all food products. The Clearwater River Casino has also ramped up their cleaning protocols and custodial staffing on site.

Is LRA planning to cancel events?

At this point in time, no. We will only postpone events if guidance is issued from State, County, or City levels. We are working with event organizers and partners, and will notify you as quickly as we can.

In the event that Horseman's Ball is postponed, you will be protected by our Ticketing Guarantee and you will have the option to hold your tickets for the rescheduled date, or to be refunded in full.

If you opt for a refund, we will send you an email when your event ticket refund is being processed. If you choose to hold onto your tickets, we will contact you over email with an update once we have confirmed the changes with the event venue.
